



Bournemouth Jubilee Wheelers

100km Reliability Trial

Clockwise Route



OS Sheets 194 & 195

Start: Merley Community Centre, Far door at end of path alongside building.

Abbreviations:	L = Turn Left	SO = Straight on	T = T Junction
	R = Turn Right	RBT = Roundabout	sp = signpost
	X = crossroads	rd = road	thro = through
	t/lights = traffic lights	fol = follow	imm = immediately

Exit car park & **R** along Harrier Drive. **L** on to Oakley Straight, then **L** along Oakley Lane to Willett Arms. **L** on B3073 then shortly **L** again at **RBT** (sp Poole) on A349 Gravel Hill. Take 1st **R** (care) (sp Corfe Mullen) and continue to **T** where **L** then very shortly at **RBT** take 3rd exit. Continue past school to **T** at **Corfe Mullen** where **R** and imm **L** down Pardy's Hill (2.7m). Continue to **T** where **R** then imm **L** to staggered **X** with A350 where **SO** (sp Lytchett Matravers). At **X** in **Lytchett Matravers** (6.3m) **R** down hill (care) & foll to just short of junction with B3075 (8.8m). **L** (care – grit on corner) and foll thro **East Morden** to **T** with B3075 at Cock and Bottle Inn.

L on B3075 to cross A35 at Park Corner (10.6m) and continue to **RBT** at **Sandford**. **R** on A351, continue over railway bridge to **RBT** at start of Wareham bypass. **L** thro **Wareham**, across river to **Stoborough** where **L** (sp Ridge, Arne). Foll for 2 miles where **R** at triangle (sp Norden) and continue across Middlebere Heath to **T** (20.4m). **R** to **RBT** where **L** (sp Corfe Castle). At **X** at foot of hill imm before **Corfe Castle** **R** (sp Church Knowle). Thro **Church Knowle** & just after animal sanctuary **R** at Barnston **X** (sp Stoborough & Wareham). Up hill through **Cocknowle** then downhill (care - hairpin bend) & shortly **L** (sp East Creech), continue thro **East Creech** to **T** where **R** (sp Stoborough & Wareham). Under railway bridge then 1st **L** (sp East Holme), **L** at **X** (sp East Lulworth) (28.5m) to **East Lulworth** where **R** (sp Coombe Keynes). Foll thro **Coombe Keynes** to **T** with B3071 (33.2m) where **R** down hill to **Wool**.

Tea Rooms on your left in Wool

At **T** **R** to cross level crossing then 2nd **L** (sp Wool Bridge) to **T**. **L** then **L** again through **Bovington Camp**. At **T** **L** then shortly **R** (sp Bere Regis) then fork **L** (sp Briantspuddle). **SO** at **X** thro **Briantspuddle** to **T** at A35 intersection (41.4). **R** under A35 to **Milborne St Andrew**. At minor **X** **L** and foll to junction with A354 (43.7m). **SO** (sp Milton Abbas) and foll to climb hill thro **Milton Abbas**. **L** at **T** (46.9m), continue uphill then bear **R** down hill to **Winterborne Stickland** (care – junction at foot of steep hill). **L** thro village then at triangle **R** (sp Blandford) (49.8m). Up hill to fork where **L** (sp Bryanston).

Continue on this road to **T** at foot of steep descent. **L** (sp Town Centre) across river Stour into **Blandford Forum**. At one way system bear **L** up hill, keeping **R** then take 1st **R**. **R** at **T** down hill (one way) then at bottom **L** then imm **R** in to Langton Rd. At end of road fork **R** on to cycle path under bypass (watch for broken glass). **R** at end of path thro **Langton Long** and over small hill to stone cross where **L** (sp Shapwick) (57.0m). Continue to Shapwick to White Mill where take 2nd **L** (sp Cowgrove) (59.5m) thro **Cowgrove** and past Wimborne FC to **T** with B3082. **R** (sp Wimborne) to mini **RBT** where **L** (sp Wimborne) and foll one way system thro **Wimborne** to t/lights (move to right hand lane). **R** at t/lights (now 2 way traffic) & **SO** at twin mini **RBTs** past Police Station to next mini **RBT** where **R** (sp Poole). At next **RBT** **R** (sp Poole) then continue up B3073 Oakley Hill to Willett Arms where **L** (sp Canford Magna) in to Oakley Lane. Shortly **R** in to Oakley Straight and imm **R** again in to Harrier Drive then **L** in to **Finish** at **Merley Community Centre**.

Note: Route is approx 2½ miles long so an extra 10 minutes will be allowed
